



**Philip K. Beachem**

Philip K. Beachem was appointed President of the New Jersey Alliance for Action in 1996 after having served as the association's Vice President since 1987.

In his capacity as the Alliance's Chief Executive Office, he has worked with elected officials from the federal, state and local level on economic and infrastructure issues important to the citizens of New Jersey and the region. He has consulted with Governors, Legislators and local officials from both political parties and is recognized by the media as a leading spokesman on infrastructure and public-private partnership issues important to the region.

Mr. Beachem has served on numerous commissions by appointment of past Governors including the New Jersey Economic Development Authority and the New Jersey Transportation Trust Fund Authority. In 1988 he was appointed by President George W. Bush to the USEPA's Environmental Finance Advisory Board. He currently serves as a member of the New Jersey Institute of Technology (NJIT) Board of Trustees and chair's the University's Building & Grounds Committee.

In 1977, at the age of 24, Mr. Beachem was elected to the first of three successive four year terms as councilman in Franklin Township (Somerset County). He was also elected twice to serve as the township's Mayor.

Mr. Beachem has been recognized for his work by numerous organizations. He was the recipient of Citizen of the Year Award by the American Society of Civil Engineers- New Jersey Section and the New Jersey Chapter Recognition Award presented by the American Public Works Association. Additional awards have been presented to him by Passaic Community College, Monmouth-Ocean Development Council, TransOptions and the Newark Regional Business Partnership. He was the recipient of the PNC Bank Arts Center prestigious "Frank Sinatra Award" in recognition of his long standing support for the Arts.

Mr. Beachem holds a B.S. Degree in Real Estate from the University of Connecticut and an MBA Degree in Finance from Rutgers University.
